Membership

- 1. Open to all women from the Basildon Area and surrounding area all members will have an equal vote.
- 2. Member will register their details and sign a form
- 3. As a member you must attend all weekly meetings
- 4. Members are not allowed to discriminate against race, colour,sex etc Discuss later disqualified rules

COMMITTEE

- 1. The committee should be elected to carry out business of group
- 2. The committee should be made up of Chairman, Secretary, Vice Secretary treasurer.
- 3. Committee member cannot hold more than one position at any one time.
- 4. The committee annual general meeting AGM
- 5. All committee members shall serve a term of three years and may stand again for re election
- 6. Committee members shall carry out duties appropriate to their position on the committee and any other duties that may arise from committee general meeting
- 7. the committee shall meet no less than four times a year
- 8. Minutes of all meeting will be available to all members

Finance

- 1. All money raised or donated to the group will be used for the aims of the group
- 2. The treasurer will open a bank account in name of the group

- 3. The cheque signatories will be made by the chairman ,treasurer, secretary
- 4. All cheques and instructions to the groups bankers will require two of the agreed signatures
- 5. The treasurer will have the accounts checked by an independent person with adequate financial experience
- 6. The accounts shall be available to all members at the AGM

AGM

- 1. The annual general meeting will be held every June at which the committee will report on its works, and present statement of account
- 2. The secretary will notify of all the dates of meeting no less than 21 days before the AGM.

GENERAL MEETING

- 1. A general meeting may be called by the committee to report on current activities. The secretary will publise any such meeting at least 21 days
- 2. The group will meet on a weekly basis excluding public holidays
- 3. If there are any changes in the meeting the secretary will notify the group within 3 days by phone or email.

VOTING

- 1. If any member may make a proposal, which must be seconded or supported by two or more people.
- 2. Before voting takes place, all comitee members must be present, in addition of, no less than three members must be present to vote.
- 3. No member is entitled to exercise more than one vote.
- 4. In the event of an equal vote, the chair will have the casting vote.

DISSOLUTION

- 1. Any proposal to dissolve the group shall take effect only if agreed by the committee members and two thirds of the members present at a meeting.
- 2. Any assets (financial or otherwise) remaining afte the payments of all debts are liabilties should be given to charitable puposes as agreed by the committee members at the meeting.
